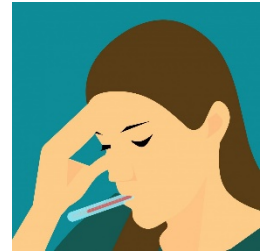




Our Plan for a Safe Reopening

Do your part to keep everyone safe:

Health Assessment: Prior to your lesson, we ask all participants to self-assess their health and the health of their children. If anyone is not feeling well, has a fever, shortness of breath, or any COVID-19-like symptoms, we ask that they contact us to cancel their lesson. Makeup Lessons will be provided as needed to ensure students who are not feeling well, may stay home and get better.



Face masks for Parents: Face masks that cover the mouth and nose are strongly encouraged in all of our pools, and will be required for entry where recommended by state and local health authorities.



Face Masks for Children: Children will not be required to wear their face coverings in the pool, but we do ask that they wear them upon entering and exiting the facility as required by state and local authorities.

Social Distancing: All family members are asked to maintain a social distance from one another on the pool deck and within the facility. You are welcome to rearrange chairs on the pool deck as needed, to reflect state and local recommendations.



Reducing our numbers: In order to reduce the number of people in the facility at any one time, we ask you to please limit attendance to **only one adult per family** during your lesson time. Whenever possible, the siblings of enrolled students should also stay at home.

Timing your arrival: Please plan your arrival to minimize your time in the facilities. Allow for just the time you need to change clothes, or better yet, have your child arrive with their swim suit already on under their clothes.

Chlorine & Bromine are virus and bacteria killers! Proper sanitizing chemistry, routinely required for commercial swimming pools, kills bacteria and viruses! When we swim in a well-maintained pool, it is the equivalent to a full-body dip into Purell! Our chemistry levels are always tested every two hours for your safety.

Additionally, our pools are all inspected weekly by an independent third-party laboratory as required by state and local regulations. A swim lesson, just by its nature, may be the safest activity for your child at this time!

We are doing our part to keep everyone safe:

Staff Member Health Assessments: Instructors and deck personnel are required to pre-assess their health well before the start of classes. Following state and local direction, anyone who is not feeling well, has a fever, shortness of breath, or any COVID-19 like symptoms, will not be permitted to work.

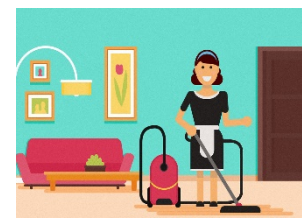
Personal Protective Equipment for your instructor:

Staff members have been provided extremely effective, **full-face shields** as an impervious barrier for use within the pool when social distancing with students is not possible. Our staff members are otherwise required to wear their face masks or shields when out of the water as recommended by state and local health authorities.



Social Distancing: Staff will practice social distancing within our facilities where applicable. When social distancing is not possible in the pool between students and staff, instructors will be wearing their full-face shields.

Facility Sanitation: We have always taken great pride in the cleanliness of our facilities. Our host providers have increased attention to disinfecting efforts, with additional attention to high traffic areas and commonly touched facility elements. Facility restrooms will continue to provide antibacterial hand soaps and hand sanitizer readily available.



Goggle Sanitation: Proper pool chemistry also works to keep our training equipment and goggles sanitary during lessons. As an added safety measure, we are providing additional goggles to our staff, allowing goggles to have 30-minute soak in chlorine between uses.
